I-90 Closed over the summit of Snoqualmie Pass

January 29, 2008

Interstate 90 is closed indefinitely due to high avalanche danger and naturally occurring snow slides. The roadway is closed eastbound at milepost 34 near North Bend and westbound at milepost 106 near Ellensburg over the summit of Snoqualmie Pass. Avalanche control work is presently underway.

I-90 will likely open and close for avalanche control throughout the day.

Heavy snowfall is expected on the Pass for the next 24 to 36 hours.

Chains will be required.

Should you use US 2 over Stevens Pass as an alternate route, expect heavy snowfall and chains required.
